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Treatment Report: Initial Examination

RE: Ramesh Adimulam

A periodontal evaluation was completed on September 12, 2017. Below is a synopsis of the clinical findings and recommended treatment for inclusion in their records.

A review of Ramesh's medical history and oral cancer screening was completed. He reports no known drug allergies and has been diagnosed with high cholesterol which he is controlling through diet. The oral cancer screening was found to be negative.

A full mouth periodontal examination was completed. Ramesh reported a chief complaint of "wanting to see a periodontist to get my teeth and gums looked at". He was diagnosed with plaque associated gingivitis, generalized advanced dental caries on teeth #3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32 with horizontal fracture on teeth #4, 5, 12, 13, 14, 17, 19, 20, 29 and 30, and 32 are partially impacted and he presents with pericoronitis, The prognosis is poor for teeth #1, 4, 5, 12, 13, 14, 17, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Ramesh has been treatment planned for tentative treatment plan of prophy, a referral to San Diego Prosthodontics, extraction with bone graft of teeth #1, 4, 5, 12, 13, 14, 17, 19, 20, 29, 30 and 32, caries control on the remaining teeth including full coverage crowns on teeth #8, 9, 24 and 31, after 4 months healing implants placement in the #4, 5, 13, 14, 19, 20, 29 and 30 positions, with restoration after four months, and begin 3 month periodontal maintenance recall. The treatment plan was given and possible alternatives to the ideal treatment as well as the risks of leaving this condition untreated were reviewed.
